February's session was spent watching parts of a 3 day training video on how Brooke Shaden creates her fine art portraiture. Brooke is from the USA and took a degree in film making and literature and when qualified, went into photography, her first love. She has used what she learnt in her degree to take photos that create a story.

Unlike normal portrait photographers, she does not accept commissions but chooses her own subjects. The picture is not about the model but about the creating a character that tells a story. Often they can be provocative and a lot have a touch of surrealism, they all were amazingly inspiring!

Her work is heavily edited in Photoshop where she often spends hours composing different photos and images to create her final masterpiece, this is then sold in a gallery.


